Event Rules

- Moore Fall Festival Chili and Tamale Contest, will be referred to as the “Chili/Tamale Contest” for the remainder of this document.
- Cooks meeting will be held at 2pm at the Moore Community Center. Chili contest meat will be inspected at that time. Tamale contest does not need inspection.
- Chili/Tamale Contest entries are allowed to be cooked at your residence or place of your choosing, with the option to cook on community grounds.
- Contestants are allowed to sell chili and tamales at the event, donations to the Moore Community Improvement Club are welcome.
- Fillers like beans, rice, pasta, potatoes, etc. are allowed; the Chili itself will be judged on aroma, color, consistency, taste and aftertaste, there are no other restrictions on ingredients.
- Tamales will be judged on taste, appearance and texture. There are no restrictions on tamale ingredients. (1) Dozen tamales per entry.
- Margaritas will be judged on taste, presentation, smoothness, and creativity. No restrictions on Margarita ingredients.
- Chili entry will consist of 4 individual cups of chili, provided by the contestant. Cooks will taste their own chili in the presence of the judges upon submission.
- Chili and tamales will be submitted at the time and place designated by the judges, no late submissions will be allowed.
- Turn in times:
 - Tamale: 5pm
 - Chili: 6pm
 - Margarita: 7pm

Prizes:

Chili Contest 1st Place Winner: 40% of total entry fees (Cash prize)

Tamale Contest 1st Place Winner: 40% of total entry fees (Cash prize)

Margarita Contest 1st Place Winner: \$50 cash prize
